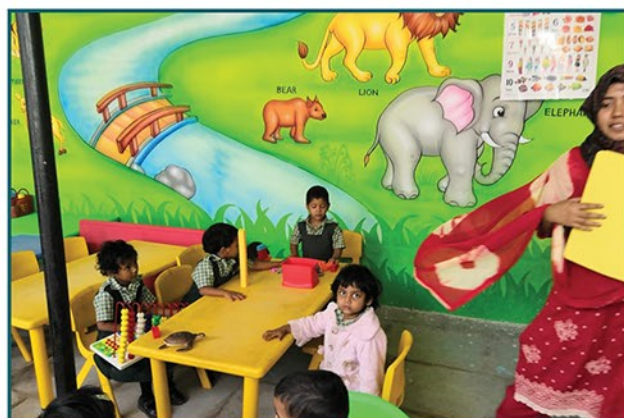

## EDUCATIONAL PROGRAM FOR CHILDREN (Rupees 27.3 Million)

- Financial assistance was given in 57 schools in 12 states in India
- Salaries were paid to 74 teachers in 11 schools.
- Opened second "SEED Elite Nursery" for slum area children.
- Funded building of a new school for poor children in Andhra Pradesh and granted \$10,000 for Science Building for a girls college in Tamil Nadu.
- Provided 30 computers to 3 slum area schools.
- Provided funds for 100 benches for one school.

### HOW YOUR DONATIONS ARE CHANGING LIVES FEW EXAMPLES

Miss MRS completed MBBS degree. SEED supported her education for last 4 years. Miss MRS's parents separated when she was young. She was raised by her grandparents. Her grandparent could not afford college expenses. SEED stepped in and Miss MRS is a doctor. She has topped in her college.



Miss MB is an orphan residing in an orphanage supported by SEED. She graduated from high school with 94% of marks. The District Collector gave her a Government Scholarship. She is studying in college now.

Miss AA is a talented girl. She scored 93% of marks in Xth examination and 97.5% in Intermediate. She got admission in BE course. Her father is a Lathe Machine Operator. He cannot afford to pay for her college education. SEED has granted her a full scholarship.



Mr. AR is a son of "Muezzin" in a small mosque. He lives in a small 3 room house with his family. He got admission in a medical college (free seat in open competition). SEED donated 80% of his tuition fee.

Miss SB is in final year of B. Pharmacy Course. Her father was employed in Saudi Arabia but lost his job. She could not pay her college fee. SEED is helping her continue her education.

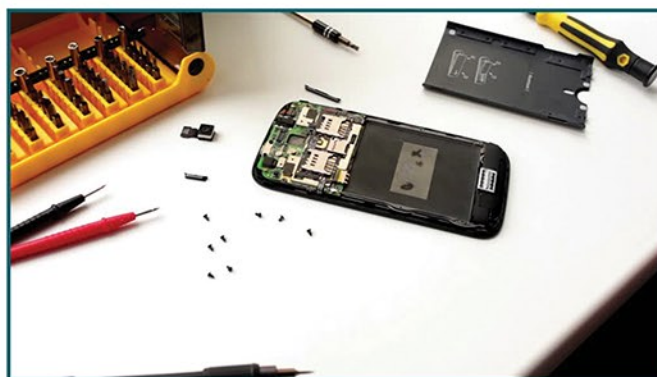

SEED partnered with a local NGO and set up a "Retail Management Training Lab". 15 computers and related equipment were purchased. Trainees get hands-on training for Retail Sales. They are given training in "Goal Setting", "Verbal & Non Verbal Communications" as well as soft skills training.

## ESTABLISHED 3 NEW TAILORING CENTER

SEED donated funds to establish 3 new Tailoring Center in Bhopal, Madhya Pradesh. 15 Sewing Machines and related equipment were purchased and training began this year. One of these 3 centers is at a Girl's Orphanage.



## FUNDED TWO JUTE MACHINES

SEED funded two Jute machines to help a women's production center start earning money by selling products. One hundred twenty women benefited from this project. They are earning Rupees 5,000 to Rupees 6,000 per month.



## WIDOWS & DESTITUTE FAMILY SUPPORT PROGRAM (Rupees 6.8 Million)

### ■ Widow was given a Sewing Machine:

Ms. A. Begum is a widow. She earns money by sewing clothes for a tailoring shop. She requested a Sewing machine and we gave her one. Now she is working from her home and is able to earn extra money for her expenses. Her only son was working as a daily wage earner. We have admitted him in one-year Automobile Mechanic Course. We are giving this family their monthly expenses. After one year, when her son completes training, this family will be self sufficient and will not need our help.

## MEDICAL AID PROGRAM (Rupees 8.52 Million)

**We are grateful to Islamic Medical Association of North America (IMANA) for their Grant of \$75,000 (Rupees 5.0 Million) that supports this program.**

**DURING 2018, 45,000 POOR RECEIVED FREE MEDICAL AID**

- **Primary Care: 29,000 patients** received primary medical care at 2 Primary Care Centers.
- **Diabetic Care: 12,000 patients** received Diabetic Care at 5 Diabetic Care Centers.
- **Dialysis Support: 900 patients** received Dialysis Treatment at cost.
- **Grant of \$10,000 was given to Mawaddah Foundation/UniCare Clinic (Bangaluru)** to provide financial aid for poor patients.
- **Financial aid to poor women for 50 deliveries** in a hospital (Deoband, UP)



### ■ Emergency Medical Relief for 2,707 Patients:

SEED is working with **Helping Hand Foundation** of Hyderabad, India to provide Emergency Medical Relief to the poor in cases of major medical emergencies like accidents, surgeries, cancer treatment etc.

### ■ New Clinic QUICK CARE

In February 2018, one mini-Clinic (Quick Care) was inaugurated In Hyderabad. This Clinic is staffed with one doctor, one nurse and one administrator. This is a trial Clinic. This Clinic is providing free of cost care to 800 patients per month.



### ■ Dialysis Machine Donated to AlShifa Clinic in New Delhi

AlShifa Clinic is operated by Human Welfare Society and it is located in Okhla Area in New Delhi. People in this city drink Bore Well Water and many have kidney issues requiring Dialysis. The Clinic had 8 machines but demand for treatment is high due to lack of machines. SEED donated funds for one machine. 900 patients per year are receiving treatment at cost due to this machine.

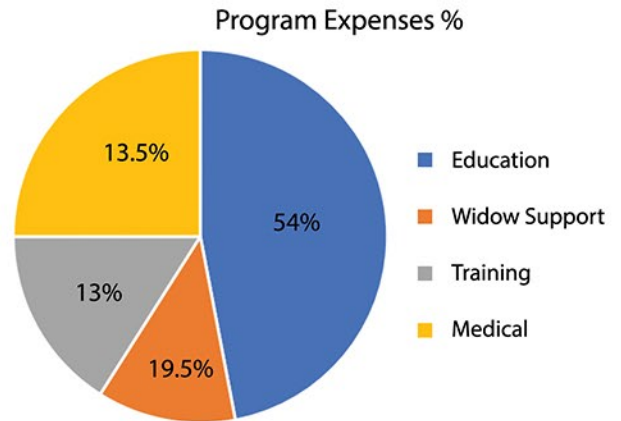
2018 Total Expenses (Aid + Local) = \$ 879,860
