Education Program

INVESTMENT IN EDUCATION \$870,280)

Financial aid for the education of 14,000 children including 2,500 orphans.

- Provided educational support for **poor children in forty-three schools in fourteen states.**
- **Granted two thousand and three (2,003) scholarships** for college education.
- **Three hundred and seventy-eight (378) scholarships** were granted to Post Graduate Students.
- **Six hundred and six (606) scholarships** were granted to BS degree students.
- **Five hundred and ninety-six (596) scholarships** were awarded to Intermediate students.
- **Two hundred and twenty-eight (228) scholarships** were granted to students in Diploma Courses.
- **One hundred and ninety-five (195) scholarships** for vocational degree program.

SCHOLARSHIPS AT MAULANA AZAD URDU UNIVERSITY (MANUU) AT HYDERABAD

This year Central Government in India cancelled all Minority Financial Aid. MANUU lost scholarships to about 1200 students. SEED used to Grant scholarships worth Rs. 30,00,000 at MANUU. After this news, SEED Board of Directors increased the Grant and SEED Granted Five hundred and eighty-six (586) scholarships in the amount of Rupees Seventy-Three Lakh and Ninety thousand (Rupees 73,90,000).

SCHOOL IN WEST BENGAL

SEED is providing financial aid to pay teachers' salaries and for Mid-Day Meal for students. The school is in a low-income area and the students come to the school without breakfast. SEED has provided funding (Rupees 25,00,000) to upgrade the unfinished school building so the students will have a decent facility.

Widow & Destitute Family Support Program (\$623,730 – 950 FAMILIES)

Financial aid is given to widows, single mothers, and destitute families so that they can live a respectable life and their children can go to school. The financial need of each family is assessed, and a monthly Stipend is given. All families are required to educate their children. These families are in Telengana State, Andhra Pradesh, Karnataka, Uttar Pradesh, Delhi, Gujrat, Maharashtra, Madhya Pradesh & Tamil Nadu.



Training Program Leading to Employment

(INVESTMENT \$332,000
3,357 TRAINEES)

This program trains and provides skills to school dropouts and unemployed youth. Free of cost vocational and other training is provided to help these youth towards employment and a respectable life.

Training Centers and Partnerships:

- **Advanced Skills Development Centers** (at Hyderabad – Telengana State: at Patna – Bihar State and at Kanpur – MahaRashtra). **The ASDC at Kanpur was inaugurated in August 2023.**
- MHK ITI (2-year diploma Courses) & Auto-Mechanic Technician Course (Bhopal – Madhya Pradesh)
- Vocational Skills Development Center - Auto mechanic; Electrician and AC technician Courses (Hyderabad – Telengana State)
- Forklift Operator Training (Pune, Maharashtra State)
- Mobile Phone Repair Training (Gulbarga – Karnataka State)
- Journalist Apprentice Program & Lawyer Apprentice Program
- English Language and Classroom Management Training Program for Teachers.
- Tailoring, Embroidery and Beautician Courses (at Hyderabad and Bhopal).





Medical Care Program

(\$ 623,150; BENEFICIARIES 380,000)

Islamic Medical Association of North America (IMANA) Granted \$90,000 for Medical Relief.

- SEED provides free of cost Primary Care and Diabetic Care services for the needy. These services are offered by operating Fifteen (15) **Primary Care Centers** and **Five Diabetic Care Centers**.
- Eleven (11) Primary Care Centers are in Hyderabad, two (2) Centers are in Jagdishpur, Uttar Pradesh, one (1) in Bhopal, Madhya Pradesh and one (1) in Delhi.
- Four (4) of these Primary Care Centers offer Dental and Eye Care services.
- In addition to these Primary Care Clinics SEED provides funding for Five (5) Diabetic Care Clinics in Hyderabad, Telengana State.
- SEED also operates Two (2) "**Wellness Centers for ladies**". These centers provide a Weight Loss Program.
- SEED's partner Helping Hand Foundation operates a "**Dialysis Treatment Center**" and a "**Rehab Center Comfort and Care Center**" in Hyderabad. These centers provide services "at Cost" to the needy. Both centers are set up by SEED.
- **New Dialysis Treatment Center in Gujrat:** In August 2023, a new Dialysis Center was inaugurated at Zakariyah Hospital, Near Sidhpur, Gujrat. All Seven (7) Dialysis machines at this center were donated by SEED donors.



■ **ULTRA-SOUND MACHINE DONATION:**

One of SEED donors donated an Ultra-Sound Machine (Rupees 20,00,000) in the name of his respected mother. This machine is installed at the Helping Hand Foundation's Diagnostic Center in Hyderabad providing imaging services to the needy at 60% less cost than the market rate.



■ **PUBLIC CARE CLINIC IN DELHI SLUM AREA:**

In July 2023, a Mini-Clinic, Public Care Clinic, was inaugurated in Delhi. This clinic provides free of cost "Primary Care" to the needy. The photo above shows a medical camp conducted by this clinic.

■ **WELLNESS CENTERS FOR LADIES:**

SEED operates two Wellness Centers in Hyderabad. One hundred (100) ladies are benefiting from these centers. These centers have weight loss training programs in addition to general fitness equipment. Qualified female trainers provide training.

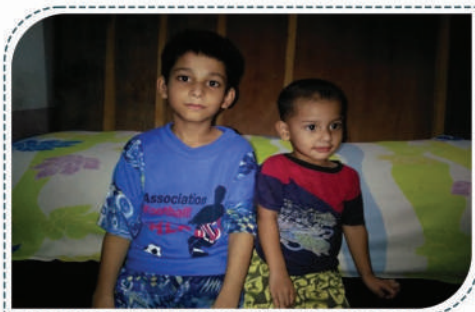
Laptops gifted to needy students

BACKGROUND

In 2016 a single (Divorced) mother contacted SEED for help for her two (2) deaf and dumb sons. Their father abandoned the family because these children were born deaf and dumb. SEED paid for "Cochlear Implant Surgeries" for both children. They learned to hear and speak after therapy. Both children are in school. After 6 years the younger son's hearing aid processor failed. With the new processor the young boy M. Uddin can hear again.

Bore Wells Providing Water in Slum Area

SEED donors funded drilling of two Bore Wells in the largest slum area in Aurangabad, State of Maharashtra. This slum area has a large population that lives without water supply.



Support to Car Accident Victim's Families

On April 24, 2023, three (3) Indian students were travelling from Chicago to Memphis to their university. Their car was hit by a Tractor-Trailer and caught fire. Two students died and the third was saved. Islamic Society of Greater Memphis raised funds to support the victim's families. SEED offered help and transferred \$42,000 (Rs. 34,50,000) to India. These funds were granted to the old parents of one victim and to the widow of the second victim.

Free of Cost Surgery to remove an Iron Rod from an Accident Victim

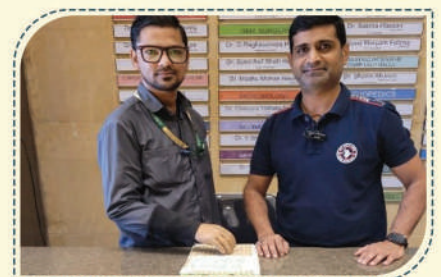
SEED paid for the surgery expenses of a needy person to remove an iron rod that was installed due to an accidental injury.



SUCCESS STORY

A Young Man can work with **SEED's Help** after losing both hands

In 2019 a young man (MM Uddin) got electrocuted and severely injured. Both of his hands were amputated. SEED provided "Automatic Myoelectric Prosthetics" that gave him the ability to regain independence. Our volunteers ran into him recently. *The good news is that he is employed at a corporate hospital Help Desk.*



Donor Recommended & Donor Paid Charitable Activities

Few Examples

■ **INTEREST BEARING LOAN PAID OFF:**

Mr. T. Khan purchased an auto-ricksha on loan and agreed to pay monthly installments. During the Pandemic he could not continue his monthly payments and borrowed money on interest by pawning his wife's jewelry. One of SEED's donors donated funds and SEED paid off his loan for the jewelry as well as for the auto rickshaw.



■ **FINANCIAL AID FOR HIGHER STUDIES IN AUSTRALIA:**

SEED provided financial aid (Rupees 400,000) to a needy student who went to Australia for higher education as recommended by one of SEED donors. This financial support was granted after verifying that the student is needy and after checking his admission as well as visa documents.

■ **REBUILDING DAMAGED HOUSE OF A WIDOW:**

One of our donors referred a widow for financial aid. Her husband passed away last year, and she has four children. She was paying her expenses by sewing clothes. In the recent rainy season, the roof of her house fell, and she could not continue to live in her house. SEED volunteers moved her into a rented house and SEED started paying her expenses. We raised funds and now her house is being rebuilt. The construction will be complete in January 2024, and she will move back into her house in January 2024.



- Br. A. W. works in a low salary job. At the recommendation of one of our donors SEED purchased a laptop as well as paid tuition fee for his son who is in an Engineering College student. SEED also paid tuition fee for his other two children (Rs. 240,000).
- SEED is paying educational expenses for a girl who is in second year of medical college. Her father works as a laborer in agricultural fields in a village in Andhra Pradesh (Rs. 60,000 per year).
- SEED paid tuition fee of three daughters of a low-income family (RS. 37,000).
- SEED paid school expenses of the children of two families whose bread earners lost their jobs. These families had not paid school fees from pandemic (Rs. 275,000).
- SJQ could not attend to his business due to an eye disease that caused blindness. He had financial hardship and ended up taking in an interest-bearing loan to pay for his expenses. SEED paid off his loan (Rs. 320,000). SEED is also paying a monthly stipend to help him.

- Paid Tuition fee for Mr. Z. J. who got admitted to an Engineering College. He is the son of a housekeeper. He has been under SEED sponsorship for the last 4 years. SEED is paying his educational expenses.

■ **EMERGENCY MEDICAL RELIEF FOR NEEDY:**

- Br. A. G. (42-year-old): Decomposed Chronic Liver disease – Liver transplant (Rs. 400,000).
- Br. M. K. (79 years old): Hypertension & Diabetes Mellitus Type 2, Acute Ischemic Stroke – Critical medical management, Hemodialysis and Oxygen support (Rs. 275,000).
- Ms. A. S. (46 years old): Heart disease – Pacemaker (Rs. 300,000).
- Ms. M. R. (17 years old): Chronic suppurative Otitis media & Sinusitis – surgery of both ears (Rs. 120,000)
- Ms. A. R (5-year-old): Congenital heart disease, left atrial enlargement & dilated left Ventricle – PDA Device closure (Rs. 58,000)
- Ms. S. K. (32 years old): Both eyes Squint: Corrected (Rs. 70,000).
- Br. A. S. S. (30 years old): Complete heart Block -Transvenous Dual Chamber Implant (Rs. 200,000).
- Br. A. I. K. (34 years old) – Lost his leg above knee in a road accident – Provided a Prosthetic Limb (Rs. 12,000).



- Hafiz M. A. (50-year-old): Right lower limb was amputated due to severe Diabetes (Gangrene) – Provided Prosthetic Limb (Rs. 1,30,000).

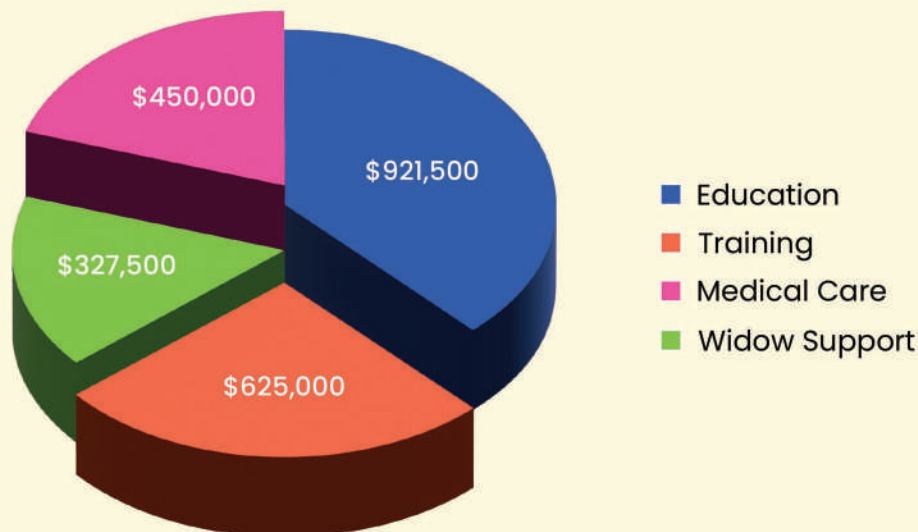
